

Appendix 1 Subsidy Control

In addition to the Royal Academy of Engineering's Terms and Conditions specified in the Letter of Offer, the following terms and conditions are specific to those grants provided as an allowed subsidy as specified in the Letter of Offer.

1. Value and use of the Award

- a. This Award has been granted on the basis that it is an allowed subsidy that has been awarded under the route specified in the Letter of Offer.
- b. The Host Organisation will provide the Academy with all information required to fulfil our obligations under the transparency requirements of the Act for subsidies over £100,000.

2. Partnerships and Intellectual property

- a. The Host Organisation will ensure that there is a formal agreement in place with any commercial organisation(s) collaborating on the Award that is in compliance with the Subsidy Control Act 2022 and the relevant scheme requirements on subsidy ratios, eligible costs and intellectual property.
- b. The Host Organisation will ensure that the assignment of intellectual property with any partners is allocated under a formal agreement which;
 - i. Does not conflict with the Royal Academy of Engineering Grant Agreement
 - ii. Does not constitute a breach of the Subsidy Control Act 2022
 - iii. Does not conflict with the subsidy scheme as detailed in the Letter of Offer.
- c. The Award Holder and Host Organisation must inform the Academy without delay of;
 - i. Any changes to collaboration agreements between the Host Organisation and partners
 - ii. Any changes to the allocation of Intellectual Property rights between the Host Organisation and any partners
 - iii. Any changes to the contribution amount from the commercial organisation that may impact the ratio of eligible costs.
 - iv. Any new partnerships developed to deliver the Grant Activities.
 - v. Any additional funding which causes a breach of cumulation requirements.

3. Record keeping

- a. The Host Organisation acknowledges that it is their responsibility to read the Subsidy Control Act 2022 in its entirety, and to seek advice (including legal advice) on its application to Host Organisation's business if appropriate.
- b. The Award Holder and Host Organisation acknowledges that the Academy and Host Organisation are jointly and severally responsible for maintaining detailed records with the information and supporting documentation necessary to establish that all the conditions set out in these Conditions of Award are fulfilled.
